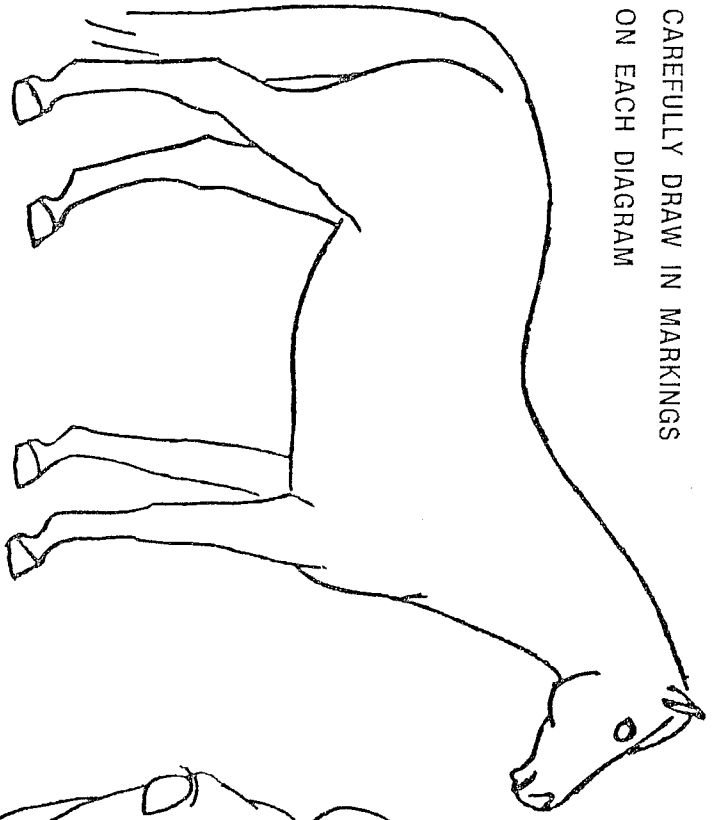


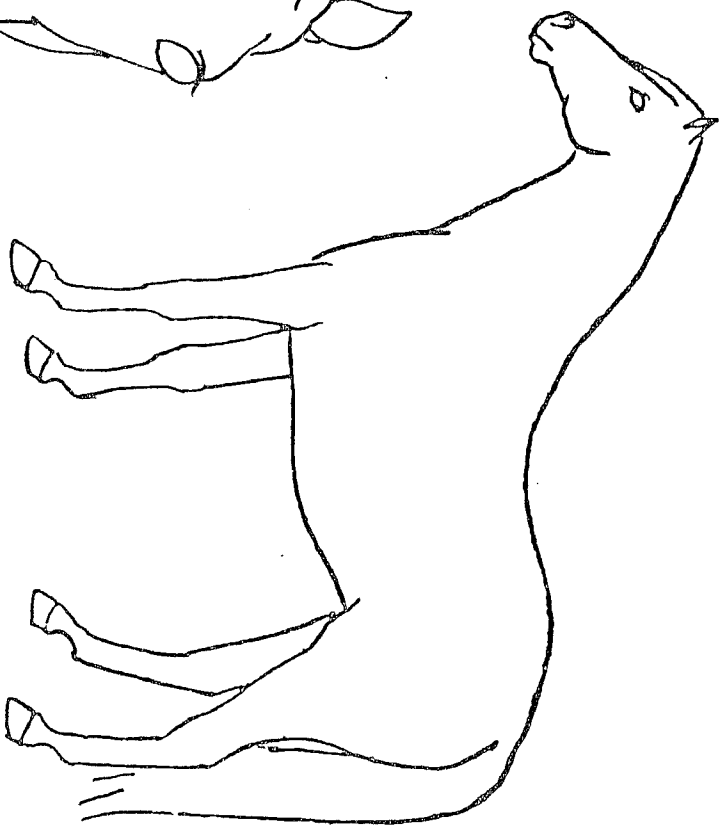
Application for Registration must contain COMPLETE description of all white markings. Failure to include such markings on applications is grounds for action under the Penalties Section of the WPCSA rule book.

Any Welsh pony or cob with large white areas having clearly defined edges on the body, except for belly spots, will not be registered. For purposes of this rule, the body is defined as the area behind a line drawn from the withers to the point of the shoulder and above the elbow and stifle. Questions regarding this rule will be decided by the Board of Directors.

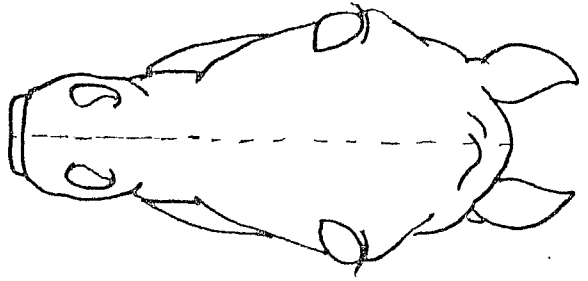
CAREFULLY DRAW IN MARKINGS

RIGHT SIDE

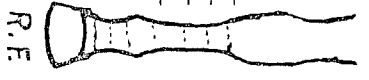


LEFT SIDE
