

EVENTING

Points will be awarded for Eventing final scores according to the chart below. Results should be submitted on Entry Form C.

For combined tests at unrecognized competitions, which consist of only 2 components, usually dressage and stadium jumping, a factor of 0.25 will be applied to values shown in Table C. For combined tests at recognized competitions, a factor of 0.5 will be applied.

For recognized horse trials a factor of 1.0 will be applied to points in Table C. For unrecognized horse trials, a factor of 0.5 will be applied.

For USEA 2-day event at preliminary, Intermediate, and Advanced levels, a factor of 2.0 will be applied.

For USEA 3-day events at the Preliminary (CCI* or CCN* level; Intermediate CCI** or CCN** level; or Advanced CCI*** or CCN***, a factor of 3.0 will be applied. For USEA 3-day events at the Advanced level CCI****, a factor of 4.0 will be applied.

A factor of 2.0 will be used for placings in an area championship (qualification required.)

A factor of 3.0 will be used for placings in the American Eventing Championships (AEC) - qualification required according to criteria listed by the USEA, www.useventing.com.)

MEDALLION AWARDS

Beginner Novice/Novice Level: One point is awarded for completion of each recognized horse trial at this level. One point is awarded for completion of each unrecognized horse trial at this level.

Two points are awarded if the horse wins a ribbon within the number of places awarded by the event or 10 places, whichever is greater. For unrecognized horse trial, 1 point will be awarded for any placing, 1st - 6th.

Training Level: Two points are awarded for completion of each recognized horse trial at this level. One point for each unrecognized horse trials.

Four points are awarded for recognized horse trials if the horse wins a ribbon within the number of places awarded by the event or 10 places, which ever is greater; Three points for unrecognized horse trials.

Preliminary Level: Four points are awarded for completion of each horse trial at this level. Eight points if the horse wins a ribbon within the number of places awarded by the event or 10 places, whichever is greater.

Intermediate Level: Six points are awarded for the completion of each event at this level. Twelve points are awarded if the horse wins a ribbon within the number of places awarded by the event or 10 places, whichever is greater.

Advanced Level: Ten points are awarded for completion of each event. Twenty points are awarded if the horse wins a ribbon within the number of places awarded by the event or 10 places, whichever is greater.

Medallion points will be multiplied by 2 for placing in an area championship. Medallion points earned in the American Eventing Championships will be multiplied by 3.

Bronze: 40 points

Silver: 120 points

Gold: 160 points

Platinum: 320 points
