

WPCSA Open Show Program Combined Driving 3 Phase CDE Division Combined Driving CT, ADT, HDT Division

In Combined Driving, each phase is considered a class (dressage, marathon and timed obstacles/cones.) The final placing is also considered a class. For shows to be counted in the Combined Driving division, the show prize list must designate the competition as a CDE, an arena trial (AT), a combined test (CT) or a horse driving trial (HDT). Competitors receive points for each phase and the overall placing. CDE, AT, CT, HDT points will be awards as follows:

Points will be awarded according to the following table:

Placing	1	2	3	4	5	6	Participation
Points	8	6	5	4	3	2	1

*The 3 Phase CDE Division consists of 4 different Divisions: Training, Prelim, Intermediate, & Advanced / FEI. The Intermediate and Advanced / FEI Levels earn Double Points from the above Chart for both the Division Year-End and Medallion Points.

*The CT, ADT, HDT Division consists of 3 different Divisions: Training, Prelim, & Intermediate.

Points are earned by the equine entry alone, but the owner of the equine(s) in each class submitted must be a current WPCSA member. An entry can constitute a Single, a Pair, a tandem, a Unicorn, or a 4-in-Hand hitch and each entry as a unit or single earn points as a unit for year-end awards in each year. If the same equine is also driven as a single entry or a multiples entry it earns points as a different entry. Each entry must pay the one-time \$35 annual fee to be eligible for the Division to qualify each year. Medallion points are earned on an individual basis over the lifetime of the equine.

All Combined Driving Division points must be submitted on the Specified Combined Driving Division form either electronically or printed and mailed to the WPCSA National Office.

Medallion Points

Bronze: 150 total points

Silver: 350 total points

Gold: 725 total points

Platinum: 1500 total points
