



WPCSA Open Show Program

Lead-Line 7 & Under Division

The Open Show Program Lead-Line Division represents points earned at any event or show that meets the general guidelines of the Open Show Program in classes marked Lead-Line in the class name or any class open to Lead-Line riders and handlers (if mounted, the Exhibitor must be led in the class) with the exception of any and all halter classes. Sanctioned, non-sanctioned, 4-H, and Schooling shows that are open to the general public to count.

Points will be awarded according to the following table:

Placing	1	2	3	4	5	6	Participation
Points	8	6	5	4	3	2	1

Points are earned by the Lead-Line Exhibitor alone, and both owner of the equine ridden / handled in any classes and the exhibitor must be WPCSA members. All Halter classes are excluded from this Division. Division includes, but not limited to, classes such as Lead-Line Pleasure, Lead-Line Equitation, Lead-Line Trail, Showmanship, Pet Pony Obstacle, and Costume classes. If mounted the Exhibitor must be led in the competition of the class for the class to be included in this Division.

Each entry must pay the one-time \$35 annual fee to be eligible for the Division to qualify each year. All Lead-Line Division points must be submitted on the Specified Lead-Line Division form either electronically or printed and mailed to the WPCSA National Office.

This Division does not participate in the Medallion Program as points are only awarded to the Rider / Handler.
