

WPCSA Open Show Program

Western Division

The Open Show Program Western Division represents points earned at any event or show that meets the general guidelines of the Open Show Program in classes marked Western or where the exhibitor may exhibit in Western tack and attire. Sanctioned, non-sanctioned, 4-H, and Schooling shows that are open to the general public to count.

Points will be awarded according to the following table:

Placing	1	2	3	4	5	6	Participation
Points	8	6	5	4	3	2	1

If the class is not specifically designated a Western Class in the premium listed class name, but allows both English and Western the exhibitor must have exhibited in the class in Western tack and attire. Both Pleasure and Equitation classes to count. Classes with Hunter, Jumper, X-Country, Driving, Trail, Halter, or Dressage anywhere in the name or the class description are not part of the Western Division and those points need to be submitted to the correct divisions.

Each entry must pay the one-time \$35 annual fee to be eligible for the Division to qualify each year. Points are earned by the equine alone, but the owner of the equine in each class submitted must be a current WPCSA member. Medallion points are earned on an individual basis over the lifetime of the equine.

All Western Division points must be submitted on the Specified Western Division form either electronically or printed and mailed to the WPCSA National Office.

Medallion Points

Bronze: 150 total points

Silver: 350 total points

Gold: 725 total points

Platinum: 1500 total points
