RULES AND REGULATIONS - Please Read Rules and Regulations Carefully for Your Benefit.

- 1) WPCSA Rules shall prevail: Any rule changes will automatically be incorporated into this show. Rule Books will be in the show office for reference, exhibitors are requested to have a working knowledge of WPCSA rules. Every entry at a WPCSA sanctioned show shall constitute an agreement between the exhibitors, WPCSW, this arena, and the WPCSA. The agreement is written in full on the entry form, participation acknowledges acceptance of all rules pertaining to the show
- 2) Eligibility: All Ponies/Cobs must be registered in the studbook of the Welsh Pony & Cob Society of America or, if under one year of age, must be eligible for registration. A Pony/Cob must be shown under its full registered Welsh Name and Number. All lease agreements must be officially recorded through the society office. All recorded leases are designated as such on the Pony/Cobs Registration Certificate. Half-Welsh and Part-Breds must be registered with WPCSA. Animals from foreign recognized registries may show, but their WPCSA points will not count.
- 3) Entries: A Copy of BOTH sides of the Registration Papers MUST accompany each entry. If you have a USEF or WPCSA Permanent Measurement Card or a measurement form from a current year's show, please include it with your entry. You must also include the WPCSA Customer Number for each owner and exhibitor. Failing to include the WPCSA Customer Number could result in WPCSA Year-End and Lifetime Points not being recorded for your entries! Please take the time to fill out your entry form correctly and completely. Exhibitor numbers will not be issued until all required paperwork, measurement, if required, and payment for all fees are completed. Entries must allow time for the United States Postal Service to deliver your entry.
- 4) Regular Entries close July 8, 2023
- 5) Late Entries: Original entries made after July 8, 2023, will be assessed a Late Entry Fee of \$20.00 per pony. The late entry fee will be charged for all original entries received after July 8, regardless of how many ponies are entered in the show.
- 6) Post Entries in Classes: Post entries in breeding classes/halter classes are accepted only up to 6 pm Friday July 21, 2023. Post entries in performance classes must be entered by no later than 2 hours before the class session begins. Post entries made in the show office within the time limits noted above will not be charged a post entry fee. All Post entries or adds/drops made at the back gate with or without an add/drop form will be charged a post entry fee of \$10/class.
- 7) Substitutions: Pony/Cob or class substitutions made in the show office are not considered Post entries but will be charged a one-time substitution fee of \$10.00.
- 8) Unruly animals of any sex will be excused.
- 9) Unsportsmanlike or discourteous behavior to other riders, handlers or drivers in the ring or outside the ring is grounds for immediate dismissal from the show by the show committee.
- 10) Junior Exhibitors are calculated for the Show Competition Year that begins on December 1. If you are 17 years old on Dec 1st, 2022, you will compete as a junior until Nov 30th, 2023, even if you turn 18 during the competitive year. Junior Exhibitors, WPCSA 18 and under, will not be allowed to handle Colts (other than weanlings) or Stallions.
- 11) **Junior Exhibitors must wear approved, protected headgear (ASTM/SEI) whenever mounted or in a horse drawn vehicle at all times on the show grounds. Any rider/driver violating this rule at any time must immediately be prohibited from further riding/driving until such headgear is properly in place. Adult western, stock seat and driving exhibitors may wear protective headgear without penalty.**
- 12) Wire wheeled vehicles will be allowed in the WPCSA Carriage Driving Classes.
- 13) **Removing the bridle from an animal harnessed to a vehicle or leaving an animal unattended while hitched anywhere on the show grounds will result in instant elimination and removal from the show grounds and forfeiture of all fees.**
- 14) WPCSA preceding a class indicates the class is eligible for national points, subject to WPCSA rules. Owners and equitation riders must be a member of WPCSA for points to count; WPCSA membership form is enclosed.
- 15) Ribbons will be awarded 1st – 6th place. Stakes classes pay \$25 to first place- minimum 3 entries in stakes class required for payout
- 16) No smoking within 30 feet of buildings, barns, kitchen or bleachers. No parking within 30 feet of the barns. No alcoholic beverages allowed on the grounds. No golf carts, motorcycles, bicycles, scooters or skateboards allowed. No electrical cords may be run from the barn outlets to RVs, campers, or trailers.

- 17) Dogs must be on a leash and are not to be left unattended. You must clean up any “deposits” left by your dog.
- 18) The show committee reserves the right to decline any entry and to return any entry before, during or after the show without being liable for compensation or damages. Exhibitors are notified that any act of discourtesy and/or disobedience to judges, officials, staff or show committee on the part of the owner, exhibitor or groom shall disqualify the animal and the owner will forfeit his entry and other fees.
- 19) Exhibitors shall refrain from dialogue with the judge until the exhibitor's last class of the show and the Judge has finished judging all of their classes. Show management is obligated to inform the WPCSA of any irregularities regarding exhibitors, judges or other officials.
- 20) The Northwest Pony Festival board reserves the right to substitute judges if necessary (with WPCSA approval)
- 21) Measurement: All Halter animals 6 years and over, and all performance animals must present a copy of a WPCSA or USEF permanent measurement card or measurement conducted during the current competition year or be measured. Ponies entered in the open pony classes must be 14.2hh or under- NO EXCEPTIONS. Ponies measuring over 14.2hh will not be allowed to compete in the open pony classes. Fees for open pony classes will not be refunded if ponies are found to be over 14.2hh by the show management. Measurements to occur: Friday 6:00- 7:00 PM, Saturday 7:00 - 7:30 AM, or by private appointment arranged with the show office.
- 22) Courses will be posted at least one hour before the scheduled time of the class. Extra copies may be available at the Show Secretary's Office.
- 23) Two (2) minute Gate Rule: To be strictly enforced. An additional three (3) minutes will be allowed for a tack change requested in advance. The Gate will not be held for more than five (5) minutes.
- 24) Veterinarian, Farrier, Medical – all listed in Show Office (not on grounds). Emergency call 911.
- 25) Food: Concessions on site.

26) National Dressage Pony Cup Partner Breed Show Rules:

GENERAL REGULATIONS

- Ponies must be measured or have a permanent USEF card.
- Ponies under 3 years of age must show proof that their Dam or Sire is a pony or member of a pony breed registry.

- WPCSA Recording fee \$7.00 per pony/cob per judge*
- Non-WPCSA member measuring fee \$5.00 per pony/cob*

- Jump fee: \$20.00 per pony

*A veterinarian or medical statement is required for any request for a refund of entry fees.

Exhibitors must wheelbarrow shavings and all manure to designated manure areas. Exhibitors must provide their own wheelbarrows. Under no circumstances should bedding materials/manure and garbage be mixed. Exhibitors will be charged \$30.00 per man-hour for cleanup of garbage left behind in stalls. Please clean all manure pits and horse wash areas after use. Trash cans are placed in aisle ways for exhibitors' use. Do not dump water buckets in stalls; a \$75 fee will be charged for cleaning up of dumped water buckets. No staples, nails or hooks may be used on the wood of the stalls.

- \$100.00 – Friday/Saturday/Sunday (includes a cleaning fee) – No bedding supplied
- \$50.00 – One day stall (includes a cleaning fee) – No bedding supplied - \$35.00 each additional day for reserving stalls
- \$11.25 per bale for shavings. Bags of shaving will be placed in your stalls. Additional shavings to be purchased through the show office. Outside shavings are allowed.
- Early arrival/late departure \$35.00 per day.
- One pony/cob per stall with exception of mare and foal.
- No refunds on stalls once they are ordered unless the request is accompanied by a veterinary certificate or doctor certificate.
- Extra nights before or after the show must be indicated on entry form. Stalls will be marked, and a stall map posted at the end of the aisles.
- Only stable your pony/cob in a stall assigned to you. If you want to change stalls, please come and see show management

Make All Checks Payable to Northwest Pony Festival. Any NSF checks must be replaced by cash, money order or cashier's check within 30 days, including all bank fees and/or collection fees along with an added Northwest Pony Festival \$50.00 charge for returned checks. Failure to do so will result in a notice to WPCSA

Division Championships: In case of a tie in a two-class division, the championship or reserve will be awarded to the animal that accumulated the most points in the Conformation Stake class. Ties in all other divisions (except hunter) will be settled by the flip of a coin. In case of a tie in the hunter division, the championship or reserve will be awarded to the animal that accumulated the most points over fences. If animals have an equal number of points over fences, they must be shown at a walk, trot and canter using the same judging specifications as in the classes offered in the division to break a tie. No WPCSA championship based on points can be awarded in any division unless all the scheduled WPCSA classes in that division have been held. All the WPCSA division classes must have three or more exhibitors showing in and completing each class for championship points to be awarded. Points for championships will be calculated as follows for all performance divisions: 1st - 5 points, 2nd - 3 points, 3rd - 2 points, 4th - 1 point.

I also agree to be responsible for any injury or damage caused by me, my horse, my employees or others under my direction and control at any WPCSA and/or Northwest Pony Festival event.
