#### **Rules and Regulations**

Show will be run according to CHJA & WPCSA Rules & Regulations

Any entry received <u>after Wednesday, May 8<sup>th</sup> at 5 pm</u> will be assessed a \$25.00 late entry fee. Entries will be accepted on the day of the show; however, they will be assessed a \$25.00 day of show penalty fee.

# TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR A MONEY CLASS (STAKES/COSTUME CLASS), THE HORSE/RIDER COMBINATION MUST HAVE SHOWN IN AT LEAST ONE OTHER NON-MONEY CLASS. PLEASE REVIEW INDIVIDUAL SPECIFICATIONS FOR MONEY CLASSES AS WELL. ALL MONEY CLASSES MUST HAVE A MINIMUM OF SIX RIDERS FOR PAYOUT.

- -All fees should be made payable to Helicon Show Stables. No refunds will be given unless presented with a veterinarian's certificate. Returned checks will be assessed a \$50.00 fee and must paid in full in cash or certified funds within ten days.
- -Stalls will be available for a fee of \$40 per show day or \$70 from Fri-Sun. The stalls will not be bedded. **Bedding** will be available for purchase onsite. Fee for a bag of shavings is \$10. Stabling is limited! Please call Molly at 720-320-7362 to reserve a stall/pen.
- -Ride Did Not Enter fees are equal to two times the entry fee per class. This includes warm up classes. It is your responsibility to enter a class in the show office. The gate personnel may let you compete but you must declare competing in the show office before you close out.
- -All Welsh entries age 6 and over must present a measurement card from the USEF or WPCSA or a current year WPCSA measurement form or be measured by the steward. All ponies in performance classes must have a measurement card. Animals only exhibiting in Junior Handler and/or In-Hand Trail are exempt from measurement. Measurements will be conducted prior to the animal's first performance class.

Junior exhibitors must wear approved protective headgear (ASTM/SEI) at all times whenever mounted or in a driven vehicle at all times on the show grounds. Harness must be secured and properly fitted. Any rider violating this rule at any time must immediately be prohibited from further riding until such headgear is properly in place.

For animals in harness, animals must be fully bridled while hitching and unhitching. Removing the bridle from an animal harnessed to a vehicle or leaving an animal unattended while hitched; anywhere on the show grounds will result in instant elimination and removal from the show grounds.

#### **Regulations**

- 1. Back to back rounds are allowed and encouraged.
- 2. Hard hats must be worn at all times by all riders while on show premises.
- 3. Schooling times may be limited if other horses are waiting.
- 4. Show management reserves the right to combine/cancel/divide any class(es) should it be in the best interest of the horse show.
- 5. Only one horse/rider combination per entry form.
- 6. One-minute gate, dotted line, and/or posted order of go may be imposed by show management in order to maintain reasonable pace for each ring.
- 7. Each class will be awarded ribbons first through sixth place. Warm ups will be judged Blue/Red ribbon
- 8. Champion and Reserve will be awarded in all divisions.
- 9. All dogs must remain on leashes at all times.
- 10. "No Judges" will be allowed

## **Health Requirements**

A negative Coggins test within one year is required for all horses entering the facility.

A vaccination record stating the animal has received regular and consistent vaccination against Equine Influenza and EHV 1 & 4 with most recent booster being within 180 days and not within 7 days. Written statements from Vet explaining reasons for being boostered with 180 days may be accepted. In no cases may the booster be within 7 days or outside of 180 days. Horses not in compliance with this rule may be denied entry to the competition grounds.

\*Horses may not have shown symptoms of or been treated for EHV-4/1 within the past 28 days. Horses may not have been at a facility under quarantine for EHV-4/1 or exposed to any horses showing symptoms of EHV-4/1 within the past 28 days.

\*All horses/ponies MUST be current on vaccinations against WNV, EEE, WEE.

\*Tetanus and Rabies is recommended.
