RULES & REGULATIONS

1. <u>Eligibility:</u> All ponies/cobs/Half-Welsh/Part-Bred Welsh must be registered with the Welsh Pony and Cob Society of America, Inc., the WPCS, the WPCSC, or, if under one year, be eligible for registration. Only animals registered with the Welsh Pony and Cob Society of America, Inc. will receive points. An animal must be shown under its full registered Welsh number and name. If the animal is under one year and not yet registered, submit a copy of the dam's Certificate of Registration, the registration number and registered name of the sire and the proposed registration name of entry. Unnamed foals may not be shown. A breeding pony may not be shown in both Section A and Section B classes, nor may a cob be shown in both Section C and Section D classes during the same year. All lease agreements must

be officially recorded through the Society office. All recorded leases are designated as such on animal's Certificate of Registration. Leased animals being shown must present a copy of registration listing the

lessee.

<u>Measurement:</u> All Halter animals 6 years and over, and all performance animals (except animals under six years and only showing in junior handler or In-Hand trail) must present a copy of a WPCSA or USEF permanent measurement card or measurement conducted during current competition year or be measured.
 Measurements to occur: day of show at 7:30 am or by appointment.
 Exhibitors, parents and/or guardians of minor exhibitors shall indemnify and hold harmless the Welsh Pony and Cob Association of California, Inc., the WPCSA and Paso Robles Horse Park, their officers, employees, and/or all Horse Show Officials and Employees
 from any and all liability resulting from injury and/or loss sustained by any person, child, or ward of such parent/guardian, in any manner occasioned.

4. Entries: If you have a current measurement card, please include a copy of it. Exhibitor numbers will not be issued until ALL paperwork is in order, payment is received, and any measuring has occurred. Entires can be made electronically at entries.silversprocket.us If mailing entries, please take time for fill out your entry form completely. Exhibitors may submit entries by USPS, email or overnight mail. Emailed entries may be accepted but will not be considered an official entry unless they are on an official entry form. 5. POST ENTRIES: Post entry fee of \$30/pony for original entries made after entry closing date. Please enter early!

6. <u>Refund Policy:</u> Full refunds, less office fee, will be given if written notice is received by the Show Secretary before the closing of entries. For exhibitors scratching a pony for any reason after the closing date a refund of unused class fees will be made, less a \$30.00 office fee, providing the balance of the classes are officially scratched on an add/drop form. There will be no refunds for classes not scratched using an add/drop form prior to the beginning of the class. Association fees will not be refunded.

7. <u>Payment of Fees:</u> A completed and signed check must accompany entries if mailed. Exhibitors submitting entries electronically may bring payment to the show, but numbers will not be handed out until payment and all paperwork is received. Returned checks will be subject to a \$25 fee and must be cleared within 30 days of the last day of the show, or disciplinary actions will be sought through the WPCSA. If you would like to pay your entries in installments, please contact Jackie at goldhillswelsh@gmail.com.

8. <u>SAFETY FIRST:</u> The safety of our exhibitors, their animals, and the public is our highest concern. Please keep your animals under control at all times and do not put them in dangerous situations. Be especially mindful of children, either inside or outside the show ring. For animals in harness, animals must be fully bridled while hitching and unhitching. Removing the bridle from an animal harnessed to a vehicle, or leaving an animal unattended while hitched anywhere on the show grounds will result in the instant elimination and removal from the show grounds.
9. Junior exhibitors must wear approved protective headgear (ASTM/SEI) at all times whenever mounted or in a driven vehicle at all times while on the show ground. Harness must be secured and properly fitted. Any rider violating this rule at any time must immediately be prohibited from further riding until such headgear is in place.

 <u>Prize Money:</u> Stake classes will award prize money as follows:
 \$15 to first place and \$10 to second place for a total of \$575 across 23 performance divisions per show. Additionally, Supreme Champion will be awarded \$15 and Reserve Supreme Champion \$10 under each judge for a total of \$600 in prize money per show being awarded. 11. Juniors are NOT allowed to show stallions.

Any unruly animal maybe asked to leave the show 12. Division Championships: In case of a tie in a two-class division, the championship or reserve will be awarded to the animal that accumulated the most points in the Conformation Stake class. Ties in all other divisions (except hunter) will be settled by the flip of a coin. In case of a tie in the hunter division, the championship or reserve will be awarded to the animal that accumulated the most points over fences. If animals have an equal number of points over fences, they must be shown at a walk, trot and canter using the same judging specifications as in the

classes offered in the division to break a tie. No WPCSA championship based on points can be awarded in any division unless all of the scheduled WPCSA classes in that division have been held. All of the WPCSA division classes must have three or more exhibitors showing in and completing in each class for championship points to be awarded. Points for championships will be calculated as follows for all performance divisions: 1st - 5 points, 2nd - 3 points, 3rd - 2 points, 4th - 1 point. 13. Any abuse toward a pony/cob/Half-Welsh/Part-Bred Welsh or show official will be cause for immediate ejection from the show without refund. 14. All dogs must be on a leash or secured at all times. 15. Management reserves unto itself the right to refuse or cancel any entries, disqualify riders, drivers, or exhibitors without incurring claim for damages. Exhibitors are notified that any act of discourtesy and/or disobedience to the judges, officials, staff or committee on the part of the owner, rider or groom shall disqualify the animal and the owner will forfeit his/her entry & other fees. 16. Courses will be posted at least one hour before the scheduled time of the class. Extra copies may be available at the Show Secretary's Office. 17. Two (2) minute Gate Rule: To be strictly enforced. An additional three (3) minutes will be allowed for a tack change requested in advance. The Gate will not be held for more than five (5) minutes. 17. Veterinarian, Farrier, Medical – all listed in Show Office (not on grounds). Emergency call 911. 18. Show Office Hours: will be posted at show office. 19. Class Splits: Halter and Performance classes will be split when possible, and championships will be offered. 20. Stalls / Tack Stalls - All stalls are \$105 Stalls are available for use Thursday 8 am through Sunday. Early/Late arrivals - \$50 per night if reserved by the entry deadline. If reserved after June 12 th it is \$100 per night (These are direct fees to be paid to the PRHP and are not increased by WPCAC.) 21. Camping - \$200 (Thursday 8 am through Sunday) Plus \$30 TOT and Assessment Fees.



You cannot break an equine's USEF Green Status at a Welsh show and adults absolutely can show any pony in any division that is open to adults and the equine is eligible for.

Classes You May not Recognize

Ridden Welsh – This class is offered for A&B ponies, C&D Cobs, and H&P equine. It is a fun class modeled after a UK style class where the ponies show to the right first and they are to show off their bold and brilliant way of going. It is ridden in English tack, involves work on the rail, and individual workout (pattern will be posted), and a strip and model. 1st and 2nd from each of the 3

classes return for the Championship class. The Championship class is judged separately, and no weight is carried into the class from the prior class but is only rail work. All equine ages 4 and up are eligible for this class and is open to adults and Jr's.

Ridder Opportunity – This class is designed to serve as a bridge between WT and Cantering. It is an entry or reentry level restricted class. It is just as much for the young rider as the older rider returning to competition. Riders are not to have competed in more than 30 shows in the last 10 years where they exhibited in classes that required the canter or lope as of the start of this show season. This is managed on the honor system and if you feel yourself or your rider are eligible for this class, we encourage you to enter!!

Child's First Pony / Leading Rein – These classes are performance classes also modeled after UK classes and are restricted to ponies of any section that are 12.2 hands or smaller. Leading Rein is on a line and Child's First is not. Both are Walk-Trot classes and entries exhibit to the right first. There are no entry restrictions on the equine or rider other than height of the pony and listed age for the rider. All cross-entry is allowed with these two classes.
