#### **ARTICLE 111.10 DIVISION POINT CLASSES**

#### WPCSA In Hand Trail (A,B,C,D,H,P)

Animals 2 & Under (Junior or Adult), Animals 3 & Over (Junior), Animals 3 & Over (Adult) Article 118.6

**Article 118.6 IN HAND TRAIL**- Open to ponies/cobs/ Half-Welsh/Part-Bred, led by juniors or adults. To be led over and through obstacles at the walk and optional jog or trot only. Tests which may be required are: negotiating a gate, carrying objects from one part of the arena to another, over logs or simulated brush, crossing a bridge, backing through obstacles, and performing over any reasonable conditions encountered along the trail at the walk and optional jog or trot only.

This class may be split according to the chart below. , but an animal may not enter more than one of those splits. To be judged 100% on performance. Year-end high score awards will be given for Animals 2 & Under, Animals 3 & Over - Junior Exhibitor and Animals 3 & Over - Adult Exhibitor.

#### Article 117.6.1 Leadline Class Specifications WPCSA LEADLINE WALK-TROT POLES

This class is designed to be a beginning hunter class for the very young riders. Judged on equitation and suitability of mount. To be ridden once around a course of four poles on the ground entirely at a walk or entirely at a trot or jog. Poles are to be placed at a minimum of four feet off the rail, two on each side of the ring simulating a hunter course. The poles should be placed far enough away from the entrance gate to provide an adequate sized area to do an opening and closing circle start the course.

# Article 117.7.1 Walk-Trot Equitation Class Specifications

# WPCSA WALK-TROT POLES EQUITATION

This class is designed to be a beginning hunter class for younger riders. Judged on equitation and suitability of mount. To be ridden once around a course of four poles on the ground entirely at a walk or entirely at a trot or jog. Poles are to be placed at a minimum of four feet off the rail, two on each side of the ring, simulating a hunter course. The poles should be placed far enough away from the entrance gate to provide an adequate sized area to do an opening and closing circle start the course.

# • Clarification of Class Restrictions for Walk-Trot/Jog Classes:

The revised wording for class restrictions is as follows for the listed divisions/classes:

RIDERS in this division may not compete in any other classes at this show that require the canter jumping (exception for trail) or cantering/loping.
