# SHOW RULES

## WPCSA OFFICIAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

All participants showing in WPCSA classes will follow the General Rules and Show Rules for the WPCSA

1. **A negative Coggins certificate** or copy dated within one year of the show is required for ALL horses or ponies
2. **Payment of Fees:** Only cash, check, Zelle, Venmo, or Money Orders payable in US Currency will be accepted. Fees must be paid in full with paper work and signatures complete **before numbers will be issues**. You can include an open check with your entries or pay the day of the show. Please make checks payable to Fieldstone park. Returned checks will be subject to a \$25 fee and must be cleared 30 days of the last day of the show. **Post entry fee is \$25. Refund Policy:** No refunds will be given unless the class is canceled, or upon presentation of a Vet Certificate/Doctors note AND notification to the show secretary before the start of the show. The Show Committees distraction will be used in all other instances. Decisions of Show Management are final.
3. **Fees:** All classes are \$20. Stakes Classes are \$40. Limited number of stalls available for \$100, includes shavings. Office Fee \$25 per horse entry. EMT fee of \$15 will apply to all entries. WPCSA Non-member Owners \$5 per owner. WPCSA Non-member Measurement fee \$5 per head. WPCSA Recording Fee \$7 per entry or \$14 per entry showing halter, with or without performance classes. Jump/Trail Fee \$20 per entry.
4. **Exhibitors, parents and/or guardians of minor exhibitors** shall indemnify and hold harmless FIELDSTONE PARK, show sponsors, employees and/or all horse show officials and employees or volunteers from any and all liability resulting in injury and or loss sustained by any person, child or ward of such parent/guardian, in any manner occasioned. Be sure to sign the release of liability attached to the entry form.
5. **Ribbons:** Ribbons for 1<sup>st</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> will be awarded in all classes. Champion and Reserve Champion in all divisions will receive rosettes.
6. **\*Prize Money:** Prize money will be awarded in all **STAKES** classes with 3 or more entries. 1<sup>st</sup>-\$25, 2<sup>nd</sup> -\$15 and 3<sup>rd</sup> -\$10. **Breeding Classes:**\$200 worth of prize money to be given out in Breeding classes. \$50 will be awarded for each judges Supreme Champion winners including Supreme Gelding.
7. **Driving: For animals in harness, animals must be fully bridled while hitching and unhitching. Removing the bridle from an animal harnessed to a vehicle an animal unattended while hitched anywhere on the show grounds will result in the instant elimination and removal from the show grounds.**
8. **All junior riders or any riders competing in any class where jumping is required and/or when jumping anywhere on the show grounds must wear protective headgear meeting or exceeding ASTM/SEI standard or the equestrian use.** Anyone violating this rule will be prohibited from further riding until in compliance. **NOTE:** protective headgear is advised and welcome in all classes of any age group, with no judging penalties.
9. **NO outside dogs allowed on the Fieldstone Park Facility.**
10. **Any abuse toward any animal or Show Official/Staff will be cause for immediate ejection from the show and premises, WITHOUT REFUND.**
11. Management reserves unto itself the right to refuse or cancel any entries, disqualify riders, drivers, or exhibitors without incurring claim or damage. Classes will be split where entries warrant. Decision of the Show management are final.
12. **Two (2) Minute Gate Rule:** To be strictly enforced. Additional three (3) minutes will be allowed for requested tack changes. The Gate will not be held for more than (5) minutes.

14. **FSC Classes:** Are Open to any Breed and are not recognized by WPCSA or USEF and do not receive point accumulation for either organization.
15. **FSC Divisions:** Are not recognized by WPCSA or USEF and do not receive point accumulation for either organization.
16. **FOOTING:** Sand footing available in warm-up areas and competition arenas.
17. **PRIZE LIST STATEMENT:** EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT USEF RULEBOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH".
18. **SAFE SPORT STATEMENT:** Competitions are required to include the following Safe Sport statement in the Rules and Regulation section of the prize list: Reminder: All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. 19. **STABLING:** Limited permanent stalls with doors are available for \$100 including shavings for the weekend or \$50 shavings included for the day.
20. **Motorized Vehicle Statement:** Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

## MEMBERSHIP

New Life members receive a complimentary pin; new Annual, Family/Firm & Annual Assoc. members receive a complimentary three-inch decal; new Junior members receive a complimentary poster.

# WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT

For and in consideration of United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. dba US Equestrian ("USEF") allowing me, the undersigned, to participate in any capacity (including as a rider, driver, handler, vaulter, longeur, lessee, owner, agent, coach, official, trainer or volunteer) in a USEF sanctioned, licensed or approved event or activity, including but not limited to equestrian clinics, practices, shows, competitions and related or incidental activities and ("USEF Event" or "USEF Events"); I, for myself, and on behalf of my spouse, children, heirs and next of kin, and any legal and personal representatives, executors, administrators, successors,, and assigns, hereby agree to and make the following contractual representations pursuant to this Agreement (the "Agreement"):

A. RULES AND REGULATIONS: I hereby agree that I have read, understand, and agree to be bound by all applicable Federation Bylaws, rules, and policies including the USEF Safe Sport Policy and Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies (MAAPP) as published at www.usef.org, as amended from time to time.

B. ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RISK: I knowingly, willingly, and voluntarily acknowledge the inherent risks associated with the sport of equestrian and know that horseback riding and related equestrian activities are inherently dangerous, and that participation in any USEF Event involves risks and dangers including, without limitation, the potential for serious bodily injury (including broken bones, head or neck injuries), sickness and disease (including communicable diseases), trauma, pain & suffering, permanent disability, paralysis and death; loss of or damage to personal property (including my mount & equipment) arising out of the unpredictable behavior of horses; exposure to extreme conditions and circumstances; accidents involving other participants, event staff, volunteers or spectators; contact or collision with other participants and horses, natural or manmade objects; adverse weather conditions; facilities issues and premises conditions; failure of protective equipment (including helmets); inadequate safety measures; participants of varying skill levels; situations beyond the immediate control of the USEF Event organizers and competition management; and other undefined, not readily foreseeable and presently unknown risks and dangers ("Risks").
