Refunds: None

Returned Check Policy: If a check is returned unpaid, the show will assess a \$25.00 fee and a money order, cashiers check or cash must be presented to show management. No premiums will be paid until all delinquent funds are collected.

Office hours: Noon to 7:00 pm on Friday. 7:00 am to close of show on Saturday and Sunday.

Show Check-in Requirements: All equine will be accompanied with a record of a negative official test for EIA (Coggins) conducted within the past 12 months. You must present the original form and not a copy upon arrival. Foals less than 6 months of age, accompanied by and nursing a negative tested mare are exempt from the testing requirements. This is a state law and show management will check papers when you arrive and if proper documentation is not present, you will not be permitted to remain on the grounds. Missouri requires an EVI (Health Certificate on animals entering from out of state.

Measurements: All Welsh which do not possess a valid measurement card will be measured as required by the official measurer. Measurement will be Friday 7-9 pm. Alternate times will be posted. It is the owner's responsibility to make a measurement time. Animals five (5) and under shown only in halter are not subject to measurement.

Stalls and Bedding: Arrangements for access to stalls prior to 8:00 am Friday must make arrangements with Denise Dougherty (cell phone: 580-402-6558) to get into the stalls. **EXHIBITORS MUST PROVIDE THEIR OWN BEDDING. EXHIBITORS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR STRIPPING STALLS AT END OF SHOW.**

Awards: Rosettes 1st-5th place. Rosettes for performance and halter Champion and Reserve and Grand Champion and Reserve and Supreme Champion and Reserve Supreme Champion. Any divisions that are not filled (3 entries in all classes in division) will not be awarded Championships. Highpoint horse and Highpoint pony awards will be given in Open Driving Divisions.

Sanctioning: This is two Provisional Welsh Pony and Cob Society of America (WPCSA) Back-to-back Double Silver Shows. All WPCSA classes will conform to the class specifications, which are included herein. Welsh performance championships are based on points only, no entry fees are required for those classes. To qualify for entry in Stake classes, the exhibitor must enter and compete in at least one other class in the division.

4 • Rules & Regulations

Classes: Show management reserves the right, with permission of the exhibitors, to cancel classes that have no entries, or to divide the classes in which the entries cannot be accommodated in the ring at one time, and to make such changes in the class schedule as dictated by the interest of the show. If there are 8 or more 12.2 and under and 8 or more over 12.2 to 14.2 hand ponies in any WPCSA class, it will be split. Classes are open to stallions, mares and geldings. WPCSA classes of less than three entries will receive reduced points and will not be combined.

Open Driving Classes: These classes are **NOT** recognized by the American Driving Society, but will be conducted following ADS rules.

SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS

In addition to the General Rules of the WPCSA

Removing the bridle from an animal harnessed to a vehicle, or leaving an animal unattended while hitched, anywhere on the show grounds, will result in instant elimination and removal from the show grounds.

Attire: Riders must be properly attired according to the rules of the division in which they are competing. Riders in all classes where jumping is required, and when jumping elsewhere on the show grounds, must wear protective headgear. Numbers must be worn and be clearly visible.

Adult Exhibitors: An individual who has reached their 18th birthday as of December 1st of the current competition year.

Junior Exhibitors: An individual who has not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1st of the current competition year. When dividing junior divisions into two separate age groups, they will be split as follows: youth 12 & under and youth 13 and over (but have not reached their 18th birthday by December 1st of the current competition year. Juniors under 14 years of age cannot show a stallion. Junior Drivers under 14 years of age must have an experienced adult (over 18) in the carriage at all times. **Junior exhibitors must wear approved protective headgear (ASTM/SEI) at all times whenever mounted or in a driven vehicle at all times while on the show ground. Harness must be secured and properly fitted. Any rider violating this rule at any time must immediately be prohibited from further riding until such headgear is properly in place.**

Missouri Liability Limitations for Livestock Activities

Inherent Risks: Missouri law protects livestock owners from liability for injuries or deaths that result from the inherent risks of livestock activities. This includes things like the animal's unpredictable behavior, potential for collisions, and hazards on the premises.

Signage Requirements: To benefit from this protection, livestock owners are required to post signs warning participants about the inherent risks and that the owner is not liable for injuries or deaths.

Scope of Protection: This limitation applies to various entities involved in livestock activities, including owners, sponsors, facilities, and auction markets

MEMBERSHIP

- a) Any person, firm, or corporation owning or interested in Welsh ponies or cobs shall be eligible for membership.
- b) There shall be two (2) classes of membership: voting and non-voting.

Voting memberships are defined as follows:

- 1. Senior Life Membership - those persons who have reached their 18th birthday by January 1 of the current year.
- 2. Annual Membership - those persons who have reached their 18th birthday by January 1 of the current year.
- 3. Family/Firm - immediate family unit - parent/guardian and minor children (who have not reached their 18th birthday) or a corporation, firm or association. The Family/Firm unit will be entitled to only one vote.

Non-Voting Memberships shall be defined as follows:

- 4. Junior Life Membership - those persons who have not reached their 18th birthday by January 1 of the current year. Upon reaching 18, the membership will become Senior Life.
- 5. Annual Associates - those persons who have reached their 18th birthday by January 1 of the current year and who are interested in the breed but do not desire full membership privileges. No reduction of transfer and registration fees.
- 6. Junior Membership - those persons who have not reached their 18th birthday by January 1 of the current year.

Privileges WPCSA Members receive: Reduces registration and transfer fees (with the exception of Annual Associate members); Privilege of appearing in the Member/Breeder Directory (with the exception of Junior and Annual Associate members); Right to compete for High Score Awards; subscription to quarterly WPCSA Welsh Review Newsletter. All new members receive a complimentary literature packet. New life members receive a complimentary pin; new Annual, Family/Firm and Annual Associate members receive a complimentary 3" decal; new Junior members receive a complimentary poster.
