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SHOW RULES

WPCSA OFFICIAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

All participants showing in WPCSA classes will follow the General Rules and Show Rules for the WPCSA

1. **A negative Coggins certificate** or copy dated within one year of the show is required for ALL horses or ponies
2. **Payment of Fees:** Only cash, check, Zelle, Venmo, or Money Orders payable in US Currency will be accepted. Fees must be paid in full with paper work and signatures complete **before numbers will be issues**. You can include an open check with your entries or pay the day of the show. Please make checks payable to Fieldstone park. Returned checks will be subject to a \$25 fee and must be cleared 30 days of the last day of the show. **Post entry fee of \$25 may be charged. Refund Policy:** No refunds will be given unless the class is cancelled, or upon presentation of a Vet Certificate/Doctors note AND notification to the show secretary before the start of the show. The Show Committees discretion will be used in all other instances. Decisions of Show Management are final.
3. **Fees:** All Performance classes are \$25 per class. Stakes Classes are \$35. Breeding classes \$25 per horse. Limited number of stalls available for \$100-, includes shavings. Office Fee \$25 per horse entry. EMT fee of \$10 will apply to all entries . WPCSA Non-member Owners \$5 per owner. WPCSA Non-member Measurement fee \$5 per head. WPCSA Recording Fee \$7 per entry showing halter, with or without performance classes. Jump/Trail Fee \$15 per entry.
4. **Exhibitors, parents and/or guardians of minor exhibitors** shall indemnify and hold harmless FIELDSTONE PARK, show sponsors, employees and/or all horse show officials and employees or volunteers from any and all liability resulting in injury and or loss sustained by any person, child or ward of such parent/guardian, in any manner occasioned. Be sure to sign the release of liability attached to the entry form.
5. **Ribbons:** Ribbons for 1st- 6th will be awarded in all classes. Champion and Reserve Champion in all divisions will receive rosettes.
6. ***Prize Money:** Prize money will be awarded in all **STAKES** classes with 3 or more entries. 1st-\$10, 2nd -\$5. **Breeding Classes:** \$20 will be awarded for each judges Supreme Champion winners including Supreme Gelding.
7. **Driving: For animals in harness, animals must be fully bridled while hitching and unhitching. Removing the bridle from an animal harnessed to a vehicle an animal unattended while hitched anywhere on the show grounds will result in the instant elimination and removal from the show grounds. *Fieldstone Park currently does not offer driving classes at its WPCSA Shows.**
8. **All junior riders or any riders competing in any class where jumping is required and/or when jumping anywhere on the show grounds must wear protective headgear meeting or exceeding ASTM/SEI standard or the equestrian use.** Anyone violating this rule will be prohibited from further riding until in compliance. **NOTE:** protective headgear is advised and welcome in all classes of any age group, with no judging penalties.
9. **NO outside dogs allowed on the Fieldstone Park Facility.**
10. **Any abuse toward any animal or Show Official/Staff** will be cause for immediate ejection from the show and premises, **WITHOUT REFUND**.
11. Management reserves unto itself the right to refuse or cancel any entries, disqualify riders, drivers, or exhibitors without incurring claim or damage. Classes will be split where entries warrant. Decision of the Show management are final.
12. **Two (2) Minute Gate Rule:** To be strictly enforced. Additional three (3) minutes will be allowed for requested tack changes. The Gate will not be held for more than (5) minutes.

14. **FSC Classes:** Are Open to any Breed and are not recognized by WPCSA or USEF and do not receive point accumulation for either organization.
15. **FSC Divisions:** Are not recognized by WPCSA or USEF and do not receive point accumulation for either organization.
16. **FOOTING:** Sand footing available in warm-up areas and competition arenas.
17. **PRIZE LIST STATEMENT:** EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT USEF RULEBOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH".
18. **SAFE SPORT STATEMENT:** Competitions are required to include the following Safe Sport statement in the Rules and Regulation section of the prize list: Reminder: All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. More information about these can be found at www.usef.org.
19. **STABLING:** Limited permanent stalls are available for \$100 including shavings for the weekend or \$50 shavings included for the day.
20. **Motorized Vehicle Statement:** Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.
The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or g guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

MEMBERSHIP

- a) Any person, firm or corporation owning or interested in Welsh ponies or cobs shall be eligible for membership.
- b) There shall be two (2) classes of membership: voting and non-voting.

Voting memberships are defined as follows:

Senior Life Membership – those persons who have reached their 18th birthday by January 1st of the current year.

Annual Membership – those persons who have reached their 18th birthday by January 1st of the current year.

Family/Firm – immediate family unit - parent/guardian and minor children (who have not reached their 18th birthday) or a corporation/firm or association. The Family/Firm unit will be entitled to only one vote.

Non-Voting Memberships shall be defined as follows:

Junior Life Membership – those persons who have not reached their 18th birthday by January 1st of the current year. Upon reaching 18, the membership will become Senior Life.

Annual Associates - those persons who have reached their 18th birthday by January 1st of the current year & who are interested in the breed but do not desire full membership privileges. No reduction of transfer & registration fees.

Junior Membership - those persons who have not reached their 18th birthday by January 1st of the current year.

Privileges WPCSA Members: Reduced registration and transfer fees (with the exception of Annual Associate members); Privilege of appearing in the Member-Breeder Directory (with the exception of Junior & Annual Associate members); Right to compete for High Score Awards; Subscription to quarterly WPCSA Welsh Review Newsletter. All new members receive a complimentary literature packet. New Life members receive a complimentary pin; new Annual, Family/Firm & Annual Assoc. members receive a complimentary three-inch decal; new Junior members receive a complimentary poster.

Note: Your dues or contribution to the association are not deductible as charitable contributions. Please consult with your tax advisor to determine whether they may be deducted under other provisions of the law (such as the provisions relating to the deductibility of business expenses).

Assumption of the Risk and Waiver of Liability Relating to Coronavirus/COVID-19

The novel coronavirus, has been declared a worldwide pandemic by the World Health Organization. COVID-19 is extremely contagious and is believed to spread mainly from person-to-person contact. WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT

For and in consideration of United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. dba US Equestrian ("USEF") allowing me, the undersigned, to participate in any capacity (including as a rider, driver, handler, vaulter, longeur, lessee, owner, agent, coach, official, trainer or volunteer) in a USEF sanctioned, licensed or approved event or activity, including but not limited to equestrian clinics, practices, shows, competitions and related or incidental activities and ("USEF Event" or "USEF Events"); I, for myself, and on behalf of my spouse, children, heirs and next of kin, and any legal and personal representatives, executors, administrators, successors,, and assigns, hereby agree to and make the following contractual representations pursuant to this Agreement (the "**Agreement**"):

A. RULES AND REGULATIONS: I hereby agree that I have read, understand, and agree to be bound by all applicable Federation Bylaws, rules, and policies including the USEF Safe Sport Policy and Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies (MAAPP) as published at www.usef.org, as amended from time to time.

B. ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RISK: I knowingly, willingly, and voluntarily acknowledge the inherent risks associated with the sport of equestrian and know that horseback riding and related equestrian activities are inherently dangerous, and that participation in any USEF Event involves risks and dangers including, without limitation, the potential for serious bodily injury (including broken bones, head or neck injuries), sickness and disease (including communicable diseases), trauma, pain & suffering, permanent disability, paralysis and death; loss of or damage to personal property (including my mount & equipment) arising out of the unpredictable behavior of horses; exposure to extreme conditions and circumstances; accidents involving other participants, event staff, volunteers or spectators; contact or collision with other participants and horses, natural or manmade objects; adverse weather conditions; facilities issues and premises conditions; failure of protective equipment (including helmets); inadequate safety measures; participants of varying skill levels; situations beyond the immediate control of the USEF Event organizers and competition management; and other undefined, not readily foreseeable and presently unknown risks and dangers ("**Risks**").

EQUINE ACTIVITY LIABILITY ACT WARNING:

Under the laws of most States, an equine activity sponsor or equine professional is not liable for any injury to, or the death of, a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities.

C. ASSUMPTION OF RISK: I understand that the aforementioned Risks may be caused in whole or in part or result directly or indirectly from the negligence of my own actions or inactions, the actions or inactions of others participating in the USEF Events, or the negligent acts or omissions of the Released Parties defined below, and I hereby voluntarily and knowingly assume all such Risks and responsibility for any damages, liabilities, losses, or expenses that I incur as a result of my participation in any USEF Events. I also agree to be responsible for any injury or damage caused by me, my horse, my employees or contractors under my direction and control at any USEF Event.

D. WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY, HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNITY: In conjunction with my participation in any USEF Event, I hereby release, waive and covenant not to sue, and further agree to indemnify, defend and hold harmless the following parties: USEF, USEF Recognized Affiliate Associations, the United States Olympic & Paralympic Committee (USOPC), USEF clubs, members, Event participants (including athletes/riders, coaches, trainers, judges/officials, and other personnel), the Event owner, licensee, and competition managers; the promoters, sponsors, or advertisers of any USEF Event; any charity or other beneficiary which may benefit from the USEF Event; the owners, managers, or lessors of any facilities or premises where a USEF Event may be held; and all directors, officers, employees, agents, contractors, and volunteers of any of the aforementioned parties (**Individually and Collectively, the "Released Parties" or "Event Organizers"**), with respect to any liability, claim(s), demand(s), cause(s) of action, damage(s), loss, or expense (including court costs and reasonable attorney fees) of any kind or nature ("**Liability**") which may arise out of, result from, or relate in any way to my participation in the USEF Events, including claims for Liability caused in whole or in part by the negligent acts or omissions of the Released Parties.


