#### WPCSA Measurement Rules

All Welsh and Half-Welsh/Part-Bred performance ponies and cobs showing in any WPCSA pointed class and all animals 6 years and over showing in any WPCSA breeding classes MUST be measured at the show or submit a valid USEF measurement card, a permanent WPCSA measurement card, or two WPCSA measurement cards issued during the current calendar year. Measurement forms will be available from the show secretary and ponies MUST be measured before numbers will be handed out. Non-WPCSA owners must pay a \$5.00 measurement fee per pony. Ponies only exhibiting in Junior Handler and/or In-Hand Trail are exempt from measurement.

#### <u>Awards</u>

1. Ribbons or other prizes awarded first through sixth place. Appropriate trophies or other awards for champions. Guaranteed prize money of \$200 will be offered in all WPCSA classes (except classes which are restricted to exhibitors 17 & under) with 3 or more entries at \$3 for first place and \$2 for second place. All prize money will be mailed within 30 days of the show. WPCSA classes with no prize money will receive appropriate awards.

2. Points will be tabulated according to the rules and regulations of the WPCSA and the points won will count towards the WPCSA High Score Awards for ponies/cobs registered with the WPCSA. Open points will be tabulated by WPCSA rules.

3. High point performance awards for top Driver, Youth, and Rider. Minimum of 10 points in WPCSA classes. Points follow exhibitor.

#### **Stabling Information**

Simon Arena is a very nice facility with plenty of stalls and wash racks. Stabling for ponies/cobs is available on the show grounds from Thursday at noon until Monday at noon. All stabling is prepaid with entry fees. Those wishing to come earlier or stay later need to make arrangements with the Show Secretary. Shavings may be ordered at the rate of \$9/bag. Shavings will be set outside your stalls. Facility rule is 2 bag minimum per stall and MUST be purchased from the facility. See entry form.

#### **Other Information**

Water is available on the grounds and there are wash bays for ponies. There is a modern and clean bathroom facility with showers for those camping overnight. Camping is available on the grounds with an electrical hookup fee of \$65/weekend (Thursday noon – Monday noon). License plate info from whatever is plugged in must be on file with Show Secretary and any campers hooked to electricity without this will be unplugged and double fined. See entry form.

#### **WPCSA Rules and Regulations**

1. All applicable classes are run in accordance with the current WPCSA rules and will be judged and conducted in accordance therewith.

2. The show committee reserves the right to combine, cancel or add classes, except WPCSA designated classes.

3. No fees paid to Heart of Minnesota Welsh for entries will be refunded for any reason unless a valid medical reason is submitted by a physician or veterinarian. Stall fees are not refundable. All disputes will be adjudicated by the show Rules Committee.

4. All registered Welsh and Half-Welsh/Part-Bred ponies and cobs over 1 year of age MUST include a current copy of their certificate of registration from the Welsh Pony & Cob Society of America or the Canadian registry or the show secretary must be able to find it on the WPCSA website. If the animal is under one year and not yet registered, submit a copy of the dam's Certificate of Registration, the registration number and registered name of the sire and the proposed registration name of the entry. Ponies over 1 year without a registration certificate must have permission from WPCSA in order to show.

5. Closing date for WPCSA pre-entries is July 4. Classes may be added for pre-entered ponies on show day. <u>Entry is</u> <u>considered "complete and received" when all information (entry form, copy of registration papers showing current</u> <u>ownership, Coggins, and payment) is received by secretary</u>. Those wishing to enter after the closing date will pay a \$50 late fee and must make arrangements with the secretary. All fees and payments to follow HMW/MPCC financial rules. Contact show manger for a copy.

6. ALL ponies and cobs MUST show proof of Negative Coggins dated within 12 months of the show. Foals at dam's side are covered under the dam's test. This is MN state law.

7. All animals coming from states other than MN and WI MUST bring proof of Health Certificate dated within past 30 days. Show this to secretary at check-in if you haven't sent a copy.

8. Stallions may be shown by ADULTS only, but MUST be under control. Unruly animals will be excused from ring.

All ponies and cobs must be serviceably sound. In case of unsoundness, judge may have animal excused from ring.
 The show committee, Heart of Minnesota Welsh, Simon Arena and their employees are not responsible for accidents of any kind or loss of personal property or damage of any kind.

11. All attendees of ponies and cobs will be subject to the order of the show and MUST have animals ready to enter the ring when required. If you have delays, you must contact the ring steward. Tack changes where needed.

12. Entries are made and accepted with the understanding that entrants are familiar with the rules of the WPCSA and the Welsh rules of the USEF. Every class designated "WPCSA" at this show is covered by these rules.

13. A fee of \$50 is required to file a protest of any kind with the WPCSA.

14. Any animal on a trail or other obstacle course before the class, will be eliminated from the competition. Courses may be walked by <u>riders</u> or <u>drivers</u> only.

15. NO LOOSE DOGS!!!!! NO TYING OF HORSES/PONIES TO RAILINGS, WALLS, OR FENCES! This is a facility rule and will result in removal from show grounds!

\* Removing the bridle from an animal harnessed to a vehicle, or leaving an animal unattended while hitched, anywhere on the show grounds, will result in instant elimination and removal from the show grounds. WPCSA rule.

\* Junior exhibitors must wear approved protective headgear (ASTM/SEI) at all times whenever mounted or in a driven vehicle at all times while on the show grounds. Harness must be secured and properly fitted. Any rider or driver violating this rule at any time must immediately be prohibited from further riding or driving until such headgear is properly in place. WPCSA rule.

Not all classes will have entries. Please listen for announcements at the show for updates. If a class does not have entries, those in the next class *will* have time to make their class! The gate will not be closed due to this, but please watch and help us keep the show going.
