- 8. Payment of Fees: You need to pay for your non refundable office fee, stalls and shavings ahead of time (see item 5 above). For everything else you do not need to send payment ahead of time, but you must leave a blank check, payable to WPCSA, in the office before you will be given your number. Once the show is over, we will not be able to sort out any discrepancies, so we highly recommend you come into the office before you leave the show to reconcile your account and fill out your check yourself. If you wish to pay in cash, you may do so, but you will still be required to leave a blank check in the office before you are given your back number. If you want to pay by credit card, you may do so by calling (540) 868 7669 and you must still leave a blank check with the office to cover any additional fees at the show.
- 9. Class Adds: For our program to be as correct as possible, we ask that you please try to make your entries as accurate as possible. However, we understand that things change and adds of additional classes will be accepted at the regular entry fee as long as they are done in the office with the proper paperwork before 5:00 PM the DAY BEFORE. Any Adds after this will not be accepted. All Drops will not be refunded. (see #10 below)
- **10. Refund Policy:** No refunds will be given unless a class is canceled, or upon presentation of a Vet Certificate/ Doctor's note and notification to the Show Secretary before the start of the show. The Show Management's discretion will be used in other instances. Decisions of Show Management are final.
- 11. Health Documents: Entries must include a negative coggins (EIA)test dated within 12 months and a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) datedwithin 30 days of the show. Foals less than 6 months of age, accompanied by and nursing a negative tested mare, are exempt from the testing requirements. Please email scanned copies of your paperwork to National@silversprocket.us. Show management will check additional papers before numbers are issued.

- **12. Returned Checks:** will be subject to a \$35 fee and must be cleared within 30 days of the last day of the show, or disciplinary actions will be sought through the WPCSA.
- **13. Prize Money:** A total of **\$2,870** is offered. All performance Stake classes will award \$25 \$15 \$10 \$5 unless otherwise stated. Grand Championships will award \$30 \$20, Supreme championships will award \$50 \$25 and Ridden Welsh Championship will award \$20 \$15. Prize money will be handed out at the show. Classes with less than 3 entries will not pay out prize money.
- 14. Stalls and Bedding: STALLS WILL NOT BE READY BEFORE TUESDAY AT 10:00 AM. A limited number of stalls may be available earlier, but you must make prior arrangements by contacting Amy Schwartz at kelviden@yahoo.com. Shavings may be pre ordered, or you may bring your own. Some additional bags of shavings will be available at the show but please try to plan accordingly! No straw bedding is allowed.
- **15. Office hours:** The office will be open on Tuesday from 10:00 am until 6:00 pm. Please try to check in as soon as possible. The office will be open 7:00 am and will close 30 minutes after the last class is finished each day.
- **16. Championships:** Championships will not be awarded if all classes in that division does not have at least 3 entries. The placings in the Conformation Stakes class of each two class division will be used in case of ties for championships. In the Hunter Divisions, championship ties will be determined by the pony with the most points over fences and in the Carriage Driving divisions, they will be determined by a drive off.
- 17. Measurements: All Welsh, Half Welsh and Part-Bred animals six years of age and older, or any animal showing in any WPCSA performance classes, MUST be measured or present valid (current) USEF or WPCSA measurement card. Exception: Animals under 6 years of age who only show in Junior Handler or In Hand Trail need not be measured. Measurement times will be posted in the show office. It is the owner's responsibility to make a measurement time before their first class.
- 18. WPCSA Sanctioning: This is a Welsh Pony and Cob Society of America (WPCSA Double Platinum Show and USEF Lite Competition and will be conducted in accordance with the rules of the Welsh Pony and Cob Society of America. Each participant in this show is responsible for the knowledge of and is subject to these rules. All WPCSA classes will conform to the class specifications, which can be found at https://wpcsa.org/compete/class-specs/
- 19. USEF Sanctioning: The WPCSA American National Show is rated with the USEF as a Lite Competition. As such, USEF members with properly recorded animals are eligible for USEF Lite points in select recognized divisions. However, this show only offers two classes in all pleasure and Pleasure Driving divisions and therefore eligible exhibitors will receive points for those two individual classes but will NOT receive USEF championship points in these divisions. USEF Championship points will still be awarded in complete Hunter divisions.
- 20. Eligibility: All Ponies/Cobs/Half-Welsh/Part-Breds must be registered with the Welsh Pony and Cob Society of America, Inc., the WPCS, the WPCSC, or, if under one year, be eligible for registration. Only animals registered with the Welsh Pony and Cob Society of America, Inc. will receive points. An animal must be shown under it's full registered Welsh number and name. All lease agreements must be officially recorded through the Society office. All recorded leases are designated as such on the animal's Certificate of Registration.
- 21. Management Decisions: Show management reserves the right to split or combine classes where entries warrant and to make such changes in the class schedule as dictated by the interest of the show. ANY abuse towards any animal or Show Official/Staff will be cause for immediate ejection from the show and premises, WITHOUT REFUND. Management reserves unto itself the right to refuse or cancel any entries, disqualify riders, drivers or exhibitors without incurring claim for damages. Decisions of the Show Management are final.
- 22. Dogs: All dogs must be on leash or secured at all times.
- 23. Physical attachment to the facility: including taping, gluing, stapling, nailing, screwing or other means of attachment, is strictly prohibited. All events will be charged a damage fee for stalls unassembled, removal of panels, the use of screws, etc. NOTE: Any damage fees incurred by the event will be charged to the responsible exhibitor.
- 24. Smoking: is prohibited in all GCFG facilities.
- 25. Driving: Wire wheeled vehicles will be allowed. For animals in harness, animals must be fully bridled while hitching and unhitching. Removing the bridle from an animal harnessed to a vehicle, or leaving an animal unattended while hitched, anywhere on the show grounds, will result in instant elimination and removal from the show grounds. A properly attired groom or passenger is required for all pairs, tandems, unicorns or 4 in hand, capable of rendering assistance in case of an emergency. Failure to comply will result in elimination from the competition.
- 26. SAFETY EQUIPMENT REGULATIONS: Junior exhibitors must wear approved protective headgear (ASTM/SEI) at all times whenever mounted or in a driven vehicle while on the show grounds. Harness must be secured and properly fitted. Any rider violating this rule at any time must immediately be prohibited from further riding, until such headgear is properly in place. Additionally, Junior Drivers under 14 years of age must always have an experienced adult (over 18) in the carriage.

(An individual who has not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1st of the current competition year is considered a junior). Adult riders in all classes where jumping is required and when jumping anywhere on the show grounds must wear protective headgear meeting or exceeding (ASTM/SEI) standards for equestrian use, with the harness securely fastened at all times. Protective headgear is advised and welcome in all classes of any age group with no judging penalties.

- 28. USEF rule regarding Junior Exhibitors and motorized vehicles: Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent(s), legal guardian(s), or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.
- 29. Grady County Fairgrounds Disclaimer: IN NO CASE SHALL THE COUNTY OF GRADY, GRADY COUNTY FAIRGROUNDS TRUST, OFFICERS OR BOARD OF TRUSTEES BE HELD RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY LOSS, THEFT OR DAMAGE OF ANY NATURE AND SHALL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE FOR INJURY OR DEATH TO ANY INDIVIDUAL OR ANIMAL THAT MIGHT OCCUR ON THE GRADY COUNTY FAIRGROUNDS, UNLESS CAUSED BY THE GROSS NEGLIGENCE OR WILLFUL MISCONDUCT OF THE COUNTY OF GRADY, GRADY COUNTY FAIRGROUNDS TRUST, OFFICERS OR BOARD OF TRUSTEES.
- 30. Under the Oklahoma law, an equine activity sponsor or equine professional is not liable for any injury of a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities pursuant to the Oklahoma Livestock Activities Liabilities Limitations Act.


