RULES AND REGULATIONS - Please Read Rules and Regulations Carefully For Your Benefit.

- 1) **WPCSA Rules shall prevail:** Any rule changes will automatically be incorporated into this show. Rule Books will be in the show office for reference, exhibitors are requested to have a working knowledge of WPCSA rules. Every entry at a WPCSA sanctioned show shall constitute an agreement between the exhibitors, WPCSW, this arena, and the WPCSA. The agreement is written in full on the entry form, participation acknowledges acceptance of all rules pertaining to the show.
- 2) **Eligibility:** All Ponies/Cobs must be registered in the studbook of the Welsh Pony & Cob Society of America or, if under one year of age, must be eligible for registration. A Pony/Cob must be shown under its full registered Welsh Name and Number. All lease agreements must be officially recorded through the society office. All recorded leases are designated as such on the Pony/Cobs Registration Certificate. Half-Welsh and Part-Breds must be registered with WPCSA. Animals from foreign recognized registries may show, but their WPCSA points will not count.
- 3) Entries: A Copy of BOTH sides of the Registration Papers MUST accompany each entry. If you have a USEF or WPCSA Permanent Measurement Card or a measurement form from a current year's show, please include it with your entry. You must also include the WPCSA Customer Number for each owner and exhibitor. Failing to include the WPCSA Customer Number could result in WPCSA Year-End and Lifetime Points not being recorded for your entries! Please take the time to fill out your entry form correctly and completely. Exhibitor numbers will not be issued until all required paperwork, measurement, (if required), and payment for all fees are completed. Entries must allow time for the United States Postal Service to deliver your entry.
- 4) Regular Entries close September 6th, 2025
- 5) **Late Entries:** Original entries made after September 6th, 2025 will be assessed a Late Entry Fee of \$20.00 per pony. The late entry fee will be charged for all original entries received after September 6th regardless of how many ponies are entered in the show. Late Entries will not be eligible for the Early Entry Bonus Drawing.
- 6) **Post Entries in Classes:** Post entries in breeding classes/halter classes are accepted only up to 6 pm Saturday September 13th, 2025. **Post entries in performance classes must be entered by no later than 2 hours before the class session begins.** Post entries made in the show office within the time limits noted above will not be charged a post entry fee. All Post entries or adds/drops made at the back gate with or without an add/drop form will be charged a post entry fee of \$10/class.
- 7) **Substitutions:** Pony/Cob or class substitutions made in the show office are not considered Post entries, but will be charged a one-time substitution fee of \$10.00.
- 8) Unruly animals of any sex will be excused.
- 9) Unsportsmanlike or discourteous behavior to other riders, handlers or drivers in the ring or outside the ring is grounds for immediate dismissal from the show by the show committee.
- 10) Junior Exhibitors are calculated for the Show Competition Year that begins on December 1. If you are 17 years old on Dec 1st, 2024, you will compete as a junior until Nov 30th, 2025 even if you turn 18 during the competitive year.
- 11) Junior Exhibitors, WPCSA 18 and under, will not be allowed to handle Colts (other than weanlings) or Stallions.
- 12) Junior Exhibitors must wear approved, protected headgear (ASTM/SEI) whenever mounted or in a horse drawn vehicle at all times on the show grounds. Any rider/driver violating this rule at any time must immediately be prohibited from further riding/driving until such headgear is properly in place. Adult western, stock seat and driving exhibitors may wear protective headgear without penalty.
- 13) Wire wheeled vehicles will be allowed in the WPCSA Carriage Driving Classes.

- 14) Removing the bridle from an animal harnessed to a vehicle or leaving an animal unattended while hitched anywhere on the show grounds will result in instant elimination and removal from the show grounds and forfeiture of all fees.
- 15) WPCSA preceding a class indicates the class is eligible for national points, subject to WPCSA rules. Owners and equitation riders must be a member of WPCSA for points to count; WPCSA membership form is enclosed.
- 16) Ribbons will be awarded 1st 6th place. Stakes classes pay \$20 to first place and \$10 to second place- minimum 3 entries in stakes class required for payout.
- 17) No smoking within 30 feet of buildings, barns, kitchen or bleachers. No parking within 30 feet of the barns. No alcoholic beverages allowed on grounds. No golf carts, motorcycles, bicycles, scooters or skateboards allowed. No electrical cords may be run from the barn outlets to RVs, campers, or trailers.
- 18) Dogs must be on a leash and are not to be left unattended. You must clean up any "deposits" left by your dog.
- 19) The show committee reserves the right to decline any entry and to return any entry before, during or after the show without being liable for compensation or damages. Exhibitors are notified that any act of discourtesy and/or disobedience to judges, officials, staff or show committee on the part of the owner, exhibitor or groom shall disqualify the animal and the owner will forfeit his entry and other fees.
- 20) Exhibitors shall refrain from dialogue with the judge until the exhibitor's last class of the show and the judge has finished judging all of their classes. Show management is obligated to inform the WPCSA of any irregularities regarding exhibitors, judges or other officials.
- 21) WPCSW reserves the right to substitute judges if necessary (with WPCSA approval)
- 22) **Measurement:** All Halter animals 6 years and over, and all performance animals must present a copy of a WPCSA or USEF permanent measurement card or measurement conducted during current competition year, or be measured. Measurement waived for animals only exhibiting in Junior Handler and/or In-Hand Trail. **Ponies entered in the open pony classes must be 14.2hh or under- NO EXCEPTIONS**. Ponies measuring over 14.2hh will not be allowed to compete in the open pony classes. Fees for open pony classes will not be refunded if ponies are found to be over 14.2hh by the show management. Measurements to occur: Friday 6:00 8:00 PM, Saturday/Sunday 7:00 7:30 AM, or by private appointment arranged with show office.
- 23) Courses will be posted at least one hour before the scheduled time of the class. Extra copies may be available at the Show Secretary's Office.
- 24) **Two (2) minute Gate Rule: To be strictly enforced.** Additional three (3) minutes will be allowed for a tack change requested in advance. The Gate will not be held for more than five (5) minutes.
- 25) Veterinarian, Farrier, Medical all listed in Show Office (not on grounds). Emergency call 911.
- 26) Food: Let's Play Cafe available at discretion of the Tacoma Unit Horseman's Arena office.

Stalls - Required per Tacoma Unit Horseman's Arena policy.

NO haul-in or trailer tying allowed

Stall fees are charged for arrival after noon on Friday. Exhibitors must wheelbarrow shavings and all manure to designated manure areas. Exhibitors must provide own wheelbarrows. Under no circumstances should bedding materials/manure and garbage be mixed. Exhibitors will be charged \$30.00 per man-hour for cleanup of garbage left behind in tack rooms/stalls. Please clean all manure pits and horse wash areas after use. Trash cans are placed in aisle ways for exhibitors' use. Do not dump water buckets in stalls; a \$75 fee will be charged for clean up of dumped water buckets. No staples, nails or hooks may be used on the wood of the stalls. **Stalls MUST be stripped clean before leaving.**

- \$12.00 per bale for shavings. Pre-ordered bags of shaving will be placed at your stalls. Outside shavings are allowed.
- Early arrival/late departure \$45.00 per day.
- One pony/cob per stall with exception of mare and foal.
- No refunds on stalls once they are ordered unless the request is accompanied by a veterinary certificate or doctor certificate.
- Extra nights before or after the show must be indicated on entry form. Stalls will be marked and a stall map posted at the end of the aisles.
- Only stable your pony/cob in a stall assigned to you. If you want to change stalls, please come and see show management

RV PARKING: \$25 per night for electrical hook-up or if a vehicle is parked blocking the electrical spots. \$10 per night for dry camping.

Ties in all other divisions (except hunter) will be settled by the flip of a coin. In case of a tie in the hunter division, the championship or reserve will be awarded to the animal that accumulated the most points over fences. If animals have an equal number of points over fences, they must be shown at a walk, trot and canter using the same judging specifications as in the classes offered in the division to break a tie. No WPCSA championship based on points can be awarded in any division unless all of the scheduled WPCSA classes in that division have been held. All of the WPCSA division classes must have three or more exhibitors showing in and completing each class for championship points to be awarded. Points for championships will be calculated as follows for all performance divisions: 1st - 5 points, 2nd - 3 points, 3rd - 2 points, 4th - 1 point.

MEMBERSHIP

- a) Any person, firm or corporation owning or interested in Welsh ponies or cobs shall be eligible for membership.
- b) There shall be two (2) classes of membership: voting and non-voting.

Voting memberships are defined as follows:

- 1. Senior Life Membership those persons who have reached their 18th birthday by January 1st of the current year.
- 2. Annual Membership those persons who have reached their 18th birthday by January 1st of the current year.
- 3. Family/Firm immediate family unit parent/guardian and minor children (who have not reached their 18th birthday) or a corporation/firm or association. The Family/Firm unit will be entitled to only one vote.

Non-Voting Memberships shall be defined as follows:

- 4. Junior Life Membership those persons who have not reached their 18th birthday by January 1st of the current year. Upon reaching 18, the membership will become Senior Life.
- 5. Annual Associates those persons who have reached their 18th birthday by January 1st of the current year & who are interested in the breed but do not desire full membership privileges. No reduction of transfer & registration fees.
- 6. Junior Membership those persons who have not reached their 18th birthday by January 1st of the current year.

Privileges WPCSA Members: Reduced registration and transfer fees (with the exception of Annual Associate members); Right to compete for High Score Awards; Subscription to quarterly WPCSA Welsh Review Newsletter. All new members receive a complimentary literature packet and decal.
