- 2. ANY NEW ENTRIES RECEIVED AFTER SEPTEMBER 8th** will only be accepted if space allows.
- 3. NUMBERS** must be worn and clearly visible whenever mounted/hitched.
- 4. TWO (2) MINUTE GATE RULE: TO BE STRICTLY ENFORCED. ADDITIONAL THREE (3) MINUTES WILL BE ALLOWED FOR A REQUESTED TACK CHANGE. THE GATE WILL NOT BE HELD FOR MORE THAN FIVE (5) MINUTES.**

5. **Stalls, Shavings and Office Fees:** Stalls, Shavings and Office Fees must be reserved and paid for when you make your entries. **These are non-refundable! NO stalls will be reserved, shavings ordered, or entries processed until we have received full payment.** If for any reason you cannot use a credit card, or you wish to pay with a check please complete the entry form at the end of this prize list and mail it with a check payable to WPCSA (in US Currency) so that it will be postmarked by the deadlines listed below to the office at:

8. **Additional Fees:**

900 series back numbers (sale ponies) \$25 (Red exhibitor numbers to indicate that a pony is for sale).
9. **Payment of Fees:** You need to pay for your non-refundable office fee, stalls and shavings ahead of time (see item #5 above). For everything else you do not need to send payment ahead of time, but you must leave a blank check, payable to WPCSA, in the office before you are given your number. Once the show is over, we will not be able to sort out any discrepancies, so we highly recommend you come into the office before you leave the show to reconcile your account and fill out your check yourself. If you wish to pay in cash or with a credit card, you may do so, but you will still be required to leave a blank check in the office before you are given your back number.
10. **Class Adds:** For our program to be as correct as possible, we ask that you please try to make your entries as accurate as possible. However, we understand that things change and adds of additional classes will be accepted at the **regular entry fee** as long as they are done before 5:00 PM the DAY BEFORE. Any Adds after this will not be accepted. All Drops will not be refunded. (see #11 below).
11. **Refund Policy:** No refunds will be given unless a class is canceled, or upon presentation of a Vet Certificate/ Doctor's note and notification to the Show Secretary before the start of the show. The Show Management's discretion will be used in other instances. Decisions of Show Management are final.
12. **Health Documents:** Entries must include a negative Coggins (EIA) test dated within 12 months and a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) dated within 30 days of the show. Foals less than 6 months of age, accompanied by and nursing a negative tested mare, are exempt from the testing requirements. Please attach scanned copies of your paperwork to your entries. Show Management will check additional papers before numbers are issued.
13. **Returned Checks:** will be subject to a \$35 fee and must be cleared within 30 days of the last day of the show, or disciplinary actions will be sought through the WPCSA.

- 14. Prize Money:** A total of **\$2,870** is offered. All performance Stake classes will award \$25 – \$15 – \$10 – \$5 unless otherwise stated. Grand Championships will award \$30 – \$20, Supreme championships will award \$50 – \$25 and Ridden Welsh Championship will award \$20 – \$15. Prize money will be handed out at the show. Classes with less than 3 entries will not pay out prize money.
- 15. Stalls and Bedding:** **STALLS WILL NOT BE READY BEFORE TUESDAY AT 10:00 AM.** A limited number of stalls may be available earlier, but you must make prior arrangements by contacting Amy Schwartz at kelviden@yahoo.com. **Shavings may be pre-ordered**, or you may bring your own. Some additional bags of shavings will be available at the show, but please try to plan accordingly! **No straw bedding is allowed.**
- 16. Office hours:** The office will be open on Tuesday from 10:00 am until 6:00 pm. Please try to check in as soon as possible. On Show days, the office will be open 7:00 am and will close 30 minutes after the last class is finished each day.
- 17. Championships:** Championships will not be awarded if all classes in that division do not have at least 3 entries. The placings in the Conformation Stakes class of each two class division will be used in case of ties for championships. In the Hunter Divisions, championship ties will be determined by the pony with the most points over fences and in the Carriage Driving divisions, they will be determined by a drive off.
- 18. Measurements:** All Welsh, Half-Welsh and Part-Bred animals six years of age and older, or any animal showing in any WPCSA performance classes, **MUST** be measured or present valid (current) USEF or WPCSA measurement card. Exception: Animals under 6 years of age who only show in Junior Handler and/or In-Hand Trail need not be measured. **Measurement times will be posted in the show office.** It is the owner's responsibility to make a measurement time before their first class.
- 19. WPCSA Sanctioning:** This is a Welsh Pony and Cob Society of America (WPCSA) Double Platinum Show and will be conducted in accordance with the rules of the Welsh Pony and Cob Society of America. Each participant in this show is responsible for the knowledge of and is subject to these rules. All WPCSA classes will conform to the class specifications, which can be found at <https://wpcsa.org/compete/class-specs/>.
- 20. Eligibility:** All Ponies/Cobs/Half-Welsh/Part-Breds must be registered with the Welsh Pony and Cob Society of America, Inc., the WPCS, the WPCSC, or, if under one year, be eligible for registration. Only animals registered with the Welsh Pony and Cob Society of America, Inc. will receive points. An animal must be shown under its full registered Welsh number and name. All lease agreements must be officially recorded through the Society office. All recorded leases are designated as such on the animal's Certificate of Registration.
- 21. Management Decisions:** Show Management reserves the right to split or combine classes where entries warrant and to make such changes in the class schedule as dictated by the interest of the show. **ANY** abuse towards any animal or Show Official/Staff will be cause for immediate ejection from the show and premises, **WITHOUT REFUND.** Management reserves unto itself the right to refuse or cancel any entries, disqualify riders, drivers or exhibitors without incurring claim for damages. Decisions of the Show Management are final.
- 22. Dogs:** All dogs must be on leash or secured at all times.
- 23. Physical attachment to the facility: including taping, gluing, stapling, nailing, screwing or other means of attachment, is strictly prohibited.** All events will be charged a damage fee for stalls unassembled, removal of panels, the use of screws, etc. **NOTE: Any damage fees incurred by the event will be charged to the responsible exhibitor.**
- 24. Smoking:** is prohibited in all GCFG facilities.
- 25. Driving:** Wire-wheeled vehicles will be allowed. For animals in harness, animals must be fully bridled while hitching and unhitching. **Removing the bridle from an animal harnessed to a vehicle, or leaving an animal unattended while hitched, anywhere on the show grounds, will result in instant elimination and removal from the show grounds.** A properly attired groom or passenger is required for all pairs, tandems, unicorns or 4 in-hand, capable of rendering assistance in case of an emergency. Failure to comply will result in elimination from the competition.
- 26. SAFETY EQUIPMENT REGULATIONS:** Junior exhibitors must wear approved protective headgear (ASTM/SEI) at all times whenever mounted or in a driven vehicle while on the show grounds. Harness must be secured and properly fitted. Any rider violating this rule at any time must immediately be prohibited from further riding, until such headgear is properly in place. Additionally, Junior Drivers under 14 years of age must always have an experienced adult (over 18) in the carriage. (An individual who has not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1st of the current competition year is considered a junior). **Adult riders in all classes where jumping is required and when jumping anywhere on the show grounds must wear protective headgear meeting or exceeding (ASTM/SEI) standards for equestrian use, with the harness securely fastened at all times.** Protective headgear is advised and welcome in all classes of any age group with no judging penalties.

Qualification Rules:

- Once an animal has qualified for the final, it is no longer eligible to qualify again.
- If the first-place animal in the regular line class has already qualified, the second-place animal may advance to the qualifying class at that show. If both first and second place animals have already qualified, no additional animals will move forward from that class.

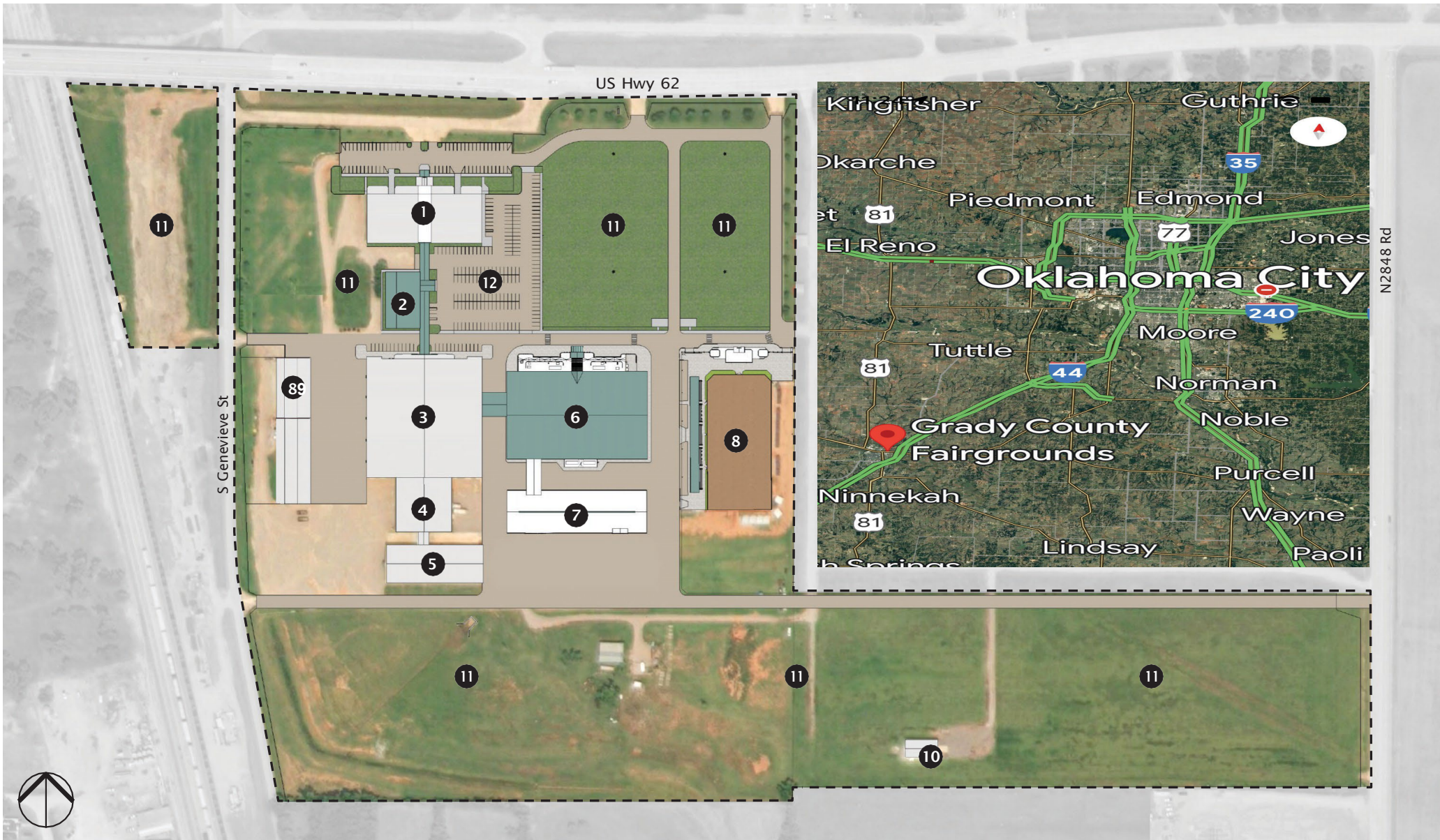
