MEMBERSHIP

- a) Any person, firm or corporation owning or interested in Welsh ponies or cobs shall be eligible for membership.
- b) There shall be two (2) classes of membership: voting and non-voting.

Voting memberships are defined as follows:

- 1. Senior Life Membership – those persons who have reached their 18th birthday by January 1st of the current year.
- 2. Annual Membership – those persons who have reached their 18th birthday by January 1st of the current year.
- 3. Family/Firm – immediate family unit - parent/guardian and minor children (who have not reached their 18th birthday) or a corporation/firm or association. The Family/Firm unit will be entitled to only one vote.

Non-Voting Memberships shall be defined as follows:

- 4. Junior Life Membership – those persons who have not reached their 18th birthday by January 1st of the current year. Upon reaching 18, the membership will become Senior Life.
- 5. Annual Associates - those persons who have reached their 18th birthday by January 1st of the current year & who are interested in the breed but do not desire full membership privileges. No reduction of transfer & registration fees.
- 6. Junior Membership - those persons who have not reached their 18th birthday by January 1st of the current year.

Privileges WPCSA Members: Reduced registration and transfer fees (with the exception of Annual Associate members); Privilege of appearing in the Member-Breeder Directory (with the exception of Junior & Annual Associate members); Right to compete for High Score Awards; Subscription to quarterly WPCSA Welsh Review Newsletter. All new members receive a complimentary literature packet. New Life members receive a complimentary pin; new Annual, Family/Firm & Annual Assoc. members receive a complimentary three-inch decal; new Junior members receive a complimentary poster.

Note: Your dues or contribution to the association are not deductible as charitable contributions. Please consult with your tax advisor to determine whether they may be deducted under other provisions of the law (such as the provisions relating to the deductibility of business expenses).

RULES AND REGULATIONS - Please Read Rules and Regulations Carefully For Your Benefit.

1. **Eligibility:** All ponies/cobs/Half-Welsh/Part-Bred Welsh must be registered with the Welsh Pony and Cob Society of America, Inc., the WPCS, the WPCSC, or, if under one year, be eligible for registration. Only animals registered with the Welsh Pony and Cob Society of America, Inc. will receive points. An animal must be shown under its full registered Welsh number and name. Before an animal is assigned a number or enters the ring, the Show Secretary must have a copy of the Welsh Certificate of Registration in the current owner's name and current Coggins test, when required. If the animal is under one year and not yet registered, submit a copy of the dam's Certificate of Registration, the registration number and registered name of the sire and the proposed registration name of entry. Unnamed foals may not be shown. A breeding pony may not be shown in both Section A and Section B classes, nor may a cob be shown in both Section C and Section D classes during the same year. All lease agreements must be officially recorded through the Society office. All recorded leases are designated as such on animal's Certificate of Registration. Leased animals being shown must present a copy of registration listing the lessee. **Welsh Ponies and Cobs are not eligible for the Mountain and Moorland Classes at this show.**
2. **Measurement:** All Halter animals 6 years and over, and all performance animals **must** present a copy of a **WPCSA or USEF permanent measurement card or measurement conducted during current competition year** or be measured. Animals only exhibiting in Junior Handler and/or In-Hand Trail are exempt from measurement. Measurements to occur: 7:30 a.m. each day of show or by appointment.
3. **Exhibitors, parents and/or guardians of minor exhibitors** shall indemnify and hold harmless the Welsh Pony and Cob Association of California, Inc., the WPCSA and Brookside Equestrian Park, their officers, employees, and/or all Horse Show Officials and Employees from any and all liability resulting from injury and/or loss sustained by any person, child, or ward of such parent/guardian, in any manner occasioned.
4. **Entries:** Exhibitor numbers will not be issued until **ALL paperwork is in order, payment is received, and any measuring has occurred. PLEASE** take time to fill out your entry form **completely**. If you have a current measurement card, please include a copy of it. Exhibitors may submit entries online, by USPS, email, or overnight mail. Emailed entries may be accepted, but will not be considered an official entry for early entry unless they are on an official entry form. Send entries to: WPCAC, P.O. Box 604, Galt, CA 95632 or email to: WPCACmail@gmail.com with WPCAC in the subject line.
5. **Early Entry Bonus:** Take advantage of our Early Entry Bonus! All entries postmarked or received on an official online entry form or on an official entry form via email by **August 20th** will be eligible for our **free stall drawing**.
6. **POST ENTRIES:** Post entry fee of \$50/pony for original entries made after **August 30, 2026**. Exhibitors may add or drop classes using www.horsespot.net at no additional fee. **All** Post entries or adds made at the back gate without an add form will be charged a convenience fee of \$10 per class. **Substitutions:** Pony/Cob or class substitutions made in the show office are not considered Post entries.
7. **Refund Policy:** Full refunds, less office fee, will be given if written notice is received by the Show Secretary before the closing of entries (**August 30, 2026**). For exhibitors scratching a pony for any reason after the closing date a refund of unused class fees will be made, less office fee, **providing the balance of the classes are officially scratched on an add/drop form**. There will be no refunds for classes not scratched using an add/drop form prior to the beginning of the class. Association fees will not be refunded.
8. **Payment of Fees:** An open check must accompany entries. Exhibitors submitting entries electronically may pay via credit card using PayPal, including fees or bring payment to the show, but numbers will not be handed out until payment and all paperwork is received. Returned checks will be subject to a \$25 fee and must be cleared within 30 days of the last day of the show, or disciplinary actions will be sought through the WPCSA. 9. **SAFETY FIRST:** The safety of our exhibitors, their animals, and the public is our highest concern. Please keep your animals under control at all times and do not put them in dangerous situations. Be especially mindful of children, either inside or outside the show ring. **For animals in harness, animals must be fully bridled while hitching and unhitching. Removing the bridle from an animal harnessed to a vehicle, or leaving an animal unattended while hitched anywhere on the show grounds will result in the instant elimination and removal from the show grounds.**
10. **Junior exhibitors must wear approved protective headgear (ASTM/SEI) at all times whenever mounted or in a driven vehicle at all times while on the show ground. Harness must be secured and properly fitted. Any rider violating this rule at any time must immediately be prohibited from further riding until such headgear is in place.**
11. **WPCSA strongly discourages the use of peacock stirrups** at all affiliated events due to documented safety concerns while they are not prohibited, riders are expected to choose equipment that minimizes risk and supports safe participation. Please note that USEF and USPC have banned peacock stirrups due to safety risks.

12. **Prize Money:** Stake and Payout classes award prize money as follows:
- \$20 stake/payout classes: 1st \$20
 - \$30 Payout/add back classes: 1st \$25 plus \$5 from each entry
 - \$30 Halter Championship payout: \$15/judge to Champion
- *All stakes/payout classes must have 3 or more entries to pay*
13. Juniors are **NOT** allowed to show stallions/colts (of any age). Any unruly animal may be asked to leave the show.
14. **Division Championships:** In case of a tie in a two-class division, the championship or reserve will be awarded to the animal that accumulated the most points in the Conformation Stake class. Ties in all other divisions (except hunter) will be settled by the flip of a coin. In case of a tie in the hunter division, the championship or reserve will be awarded to the animal that accumulated the most points over fences. If animals have an equal number of points over fences, they must be shown at a walk, trot and canter using the same judging specifications as in the classes offered in the division to break a tie. No WPCSA championship based on points can be awarded in any division unless all of the scheduled WPCSA classes in that division have been held. All of the WPCSA division classes must have three or more exhibitors showing in and completing each class for championship points to be awarded. Points for championships will be calculated as follows for all performance divisions: 1st - 5 points, 2nd - 3 points, 3rd - 2 points, 4th - 1 point.
15. **High Point Awards:** High Point Awards will be calculated based on all classes offered over both shows and will be awarded for the following categories (additional categories will be added if sponsored):
Leadline (all classes with Leadline in the title and Junior Handler classes count); **Walk-Trot** (all classes with Walk-Trot in the title and Junior Handler count); **Junior Exhibitor** (all classes entered by a junior 17 & Under).
16. Any abuse toward any equine or show official will be cause for immediate ejection from the show without refund.
17. All dogs must be on leash or secured at all times.
18. Management reserves unto itself the right to refuse or cancel any entries, disqualify riders, drivers, or exhibitors without incurring claim for damages. Exhibitors are notified that any act of discourtesy and/or disobedience to the judges, officials, staff or committee on the part of the owner, rider or groom shall disqualify the animal and the owner will forfeit his/her entry and other fees.
19. Courses will be posted at least one hour before the scheduled time of the class. Extra copies may be available at the Show Secretary's Office.
20. **Two (2) minute Gate Rule:** To be strictly enforced. Additional three (3) minutes will be allowed for a tack change requested in advance. The Gate will not be held for more than five (5) minutes.
21. **Stalls/Tack Rooms:** \$100 - stall; \$85 Tack Room. Show grounds will open **Wednesday, September 2, 2026**. Early arrival fee \$20/stall for arrivals before Wednesday September 2, 2026 at 8am.
22. **Camping:** \$65/night with hookups. Limited number of 50 AMP hookups available – 1x \$50 fee in addition to daily fee. \$40/night with no hookups. Brookside will assign camping spaces. On-site rentals – call (916) 682-1403 for pricing/reservations.
23. **Shavings:** \$12.50/bale. No outside deliveries allowed. \$10 cleaning fee if shavings not purchased from Brookside.
24. **Veterinarian, Farrier, Medical** – all listed in Show Office (not on grounds). Emergency call 911.
25. **Show Office Hours:** Will be posted at the Show Office.
26. **Open Cards:** Hunter and Trail classes may be judged on open cards.
27. **Class Splits:** Halter and Performance classes will be split whenever possible and time allows, and championships will be offered. Performance classes may be combined if entries warrant.
28. **Meals:** Brookside Café offers a wide variety of food for Breakfast and Lunch and has snacks, carrots and ice available. Silky's Pub is open and offers light meals after hours and libations throughout the afternoon and evening.

From Hwy. #99: Follow your online map directions to the Sacramento Area and get onto Hwy. 99. Coming from the North, take the Sheldon Road Exit, go east over the freeway and stay on Sheldon until it dead ends into Grant Line Road. Turn left and go approximately ½ to ¾ mile to Brookside Equestrian Park (big sign at driveway) and turn right – go to the end and you will be there.

Coming from the South, take Grant Line Road, go east (north-east) approximately 6 miles to Bradley Ranch Road. This will be a short distance from the intersection of Wilton Road, and Sheldon Feed is on the left side of the road by the railroad tracks.
